Company History

Tracing its origins to the era of sailboat trade in 1948, the founder, Mr. Wu Tsung-Ming, navigated the bustling east and west shores of Keelung Port in Taiwan. Having witnessed the ebbs and flows of the inspection brokerage industry, he established Sang Shing Inspection & Quarantine Co., Ltd. in 1976, seizing the opportunities of the time.

With the advancement of Taiwan's economy and the government's progressive policies, Sang Shing has upheld its commitment to integrity and professionalism. Despite economic challenges, the company has never wavered in its dedication to excellence. Leveraging decades of hands-on experience, Sang Shing has earned repeated recognition from the government and has been invited to serve as an industry representative in shaping administrative policies. Above all, the company places the highest priority on enhancing the expertise and qualifications of its staff, viewing this as the cornerstone of its operations.

Milestones

- 1976: Sang Shing was established, providing import and export inspection services in the Keelung and Taoyuan regions.
- 1990: Initiated digital transformation by implementing system informatization and establishing digital hardware infrastructure.
- 1993: Collaborated with the Keelung Branch of the Bureau of Standards, Metrology and Inspection to transition into the digital era with automated inspection processes.
- 1994: Introduced office automation and launched employee training programs to enhance operational efficiency.
- 1995: In June, established an office at Taoyuan International Airport to expand service capabilities. The founder retired in the same year.
- **2001**: Set up an IT department to develop proprietary management and accounting system software. Fully upgraded office automation to the Windows platform.
- **2002**: In August, obtained approval to conduct labeling translation and application for bonded goods (including food) in a self-managed bonded warehouse.
- **2004**: Launched the company website (http://www.ssinsp.com.tw) to enable transparent customs clearance processes.
- 2005: In September, acquired an HPLC (High-Performance Liquid Chromatography) system and established a laboratory for testing non-volatile food additives, further expanding service offerings.
- 2006: In July, developed a liquor inspection management system, officially

- commencing liquor inspection operations for the National Treasury Administration.
- **2007**: In March, established an alkali titration and aeration distillation system to test sulfur dioxide (SO2) residues. In January, relocated the company to the 11th floor of No. 20, Zhongyi 1st Road, consolidating laboratory management.
- **2011**: In January, with the establishment of the Taiwan Food and Drug Administration (TFDA), elevated standards for food safety professionalism were introduced.
- **2013**: In January, implemented XML-based document approval specifications and developed an automated notification system.
- **2014**: In January, launched an automated email notification system for document approval updates.
- 2015: In July, established Sang Shing Inspection Technology Co., Ltd. to align
 with national policies on self-managed food inspection. Concurrently, founded
 Sang Shing Warehousing Co., Ltd. to expand processing and logistics
 operations.
- 2016: In June, commenced operations at the Taipei Port Free Trade Zone. By the end of the year, completed the construction of a refrigerated and frozen storage facility at Taipei Port.
- 2017: In June, developed a mobile app integrated with email and SMS notifications, providing real-time updates on inspection results, cargo status, and customs clearance. In July, acquired container trucks and trailers at the Taipei Port Free Trade Zone, initiating cargo transportation services.
- 2018: In March, Sang Shing Inspection Technology Co., Ltd. obtained certification as a food testing laboratory from the Taiwan Food and Drug Administration. In July, established Sang Shing Transportation Co., Ltd., officially commencing container transportation operations, including cold-chain logistics. In November, Sang Shing Warehousing Co., Ltd. set up a general logistics warehouse in the Guanyin District of Taoyuan, operating non-bonded warehousing services.
- **2020**: In March, Sang Shing Inspection Technology Co., Ltd. established a microbiological testing laboratory.
